Technology for Persons with Hearing Loss is a demonstration that looks at technology that can improve access at home, work and in social settings.

The following equipment will be demonstrated:

- Adaptive Telephone Equipment Loan (ATEL) Program equipment, which include amplified phones, and the CapTel. The CapTel is a fairly new technology that allows you to view word-for-word captions of your telephone conversations.
- Signaling devices such as alarm clocks telephone ringers, doorbells and baby monitors.
- Personal amplification for conversations, meetings and social events and television.

All attendees can loan out equipment, on a first-come, first-serve basis, to see if the equipment is appropriate for their needs. Also, qualified attendees can apply for a **FREE** telephone thru the ATEL Program.
