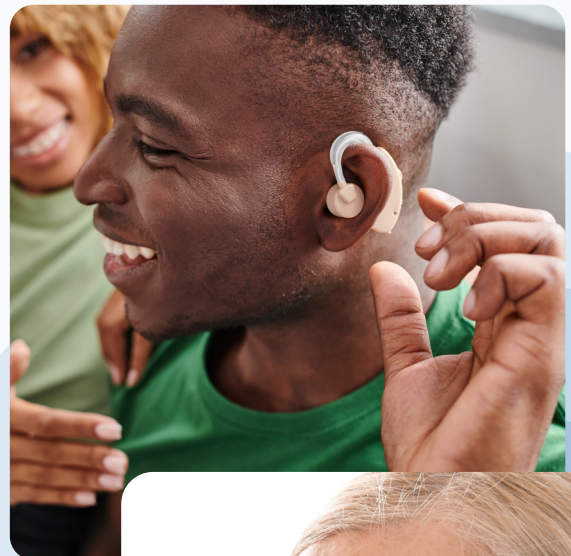
Each month highlights a different topic designed to provide resources, tools, and encouragement for everyday life. Participants will leave with helpful strategies and a stronger sense of community.
